Please pay close attention to the information below about Education Freedom Accounts (EFAs) and Education Tax Credit (ETC) Scholarships. Both of these programs are managed by the New Hampshire Children's Scholarship Fund. **Applying for these programs will be step one for anyone receiving any financial assistance for the 2022-2023 school year**. I strongly encourage everyone to take a few minutes to review the details <u>carefully</u>, and if you are eligible, please apply promptly.

You may have noticed on the calendar below that we have started attending **Stations of the Cross** on Friday afternoons. We will be doing this throughout the Lenten season. Parents and other family members are welcome to join us for this special time of prayer and reflection. Stations are held in St. Bernard's Church, but be sure to pay close attention as the time changes slightly from week to week.

EDUCATION TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS

The application is open for 2022-2023 for NH Education Tax Credit Scholarships. The eligibility is:

- 1. You must be a New Hampshire resident.
- 2. You must have a child/children between the ages of 5 and 20 who is entering

Kindergarten or **1st grade** for the first time <u>OR</u> entering 2nd-12th grades and coming from a public school.

3. Your household income must not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. See income chart below.

EDUCATION FREEDOM ACCOUNTS

The application is open for 2022-2023 for NH Education Freedom Accounts. You can direct part of your child's state education funding to pay for tuition at SJRS/OLMA. The eligibility is:

- 1. You must be a New Hampshire resident.
- 2. Your child must be at least 5 years old and no older than 20 years old and **entering Kindergarten 12th grade**.
- 3. Your household income must not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. See income chart below.

Both of the above programs are administered by the **Children's Scholarship Fund New Hampshire**, and applications are currently being accepted for new and returning families. The applications for both programs are simple and entirely online. We strongly encourage everyone who is eligible to apply as soon as possible. Many of our families receive funding from these great programs. There is a combined application for the programs so that you may apply for both at the same time, if you qualify for both. **You may receive funding from BOTH programs if eligible.
