Greetings SJRS Families, Faculty and Staff,

I want to extend a huge THANK YOU to everyone in our school community for all of the time and effort that was put into our **NEASC accreditation Program visit** this week. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday were stressful days with our visiting committee members moving throughout the buildings and observing all of our regular activities. But everyone worked very hard together! We received extremely positive feedback from the visiting committee members in the exit interview. We will receive our final report from the committee in a few weeks and will share that with everyone at that time. Our schools will now be on the agenda for an accreditation vote at the next NEASC Board of Trustees meeting in February. I will continue to update you going forward, and hope to have some official good news to share in mid-February.

A few notes to help you plan accordingly for our **Halloween festivities** on Monday, 10/31:

- * Monday, 10/31, will be a Dress Down Day with a \$1 donation to benefit UNICEF.
