ACTIVITY NIGHT -- MAY 5 -- GIFT CARD DONATIONS NEEDED!



Over the last three years, SJRS has been gifted several large donations of books. In 2021, the **Chaput Family** gave the school almost 300 books. In the spring of 2022, the **Hodgman Family** gave us nearly 800 books and in September of 2022, the **Guardiano Family** donated about 400 books. The majority of all of these wonderful books have been making their way to our library shelves. It takes some time to sort, process and prepare them to take their places for our students' reading and learning, and so it may not be immediately evident that we have collected so many new titles, but we are making progress. **To date, there have been more than 600 books added to our library collection this year alone. EDUCATION TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS

The application is open for 2023-2024 for NH Education Tax Credit Scholarships.

- 1. You must be a New Hampshire resident.
- 2. You must have a child/children between the ages of 5 and 20 who is entering_Kindergarten or 1st grade for the first time OR entering 2nd-12th grades and coming from a public school.
- 3. Your household income must not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. See income chart below.

EDUCATION FREEDOM ACCOUNTS

The application is open for 2023-2024 for NH Education Freedom Accounts. You can direct all/part of your child's state education funding to pay for tuition at SJRS/OLMA.

- 1. You must be a New Hampshire resident.
- 2. Your child must be at least 5 years old and no older than 20 years old and entering Kindergarten 12th grade.
- 3. Your household income must not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. *See income chart below*.

Both of the above programs are administered by the Children's Scholarship Fund New Hampshire, and applications are currently being accepted for new and returning families. **The**

applications for both programs are simple and entirely online. We strongly encourage everyone who is eligible to apply as soon as possible. Many of our families receive funding from these great programs. There is a combined application for the programs so that you may apply for both at the same time, if you qualify for both. 


Our Girl Scout Troop 59010
